Respectful Behaviour:

Delegates are expected to treat all participants including fellow delegates, members of the management, and other event attendees with respect. Abusive, bullying, or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.

Dress Code:

Delegates should wear appropriate formal attire throughout the event. School uniforms are acceptable. Eastern Formal, and Western Formal (Suit / Dresses knee length and below are allowed. However, Jeans, crops, tubes, skirts, or open shoes are not allowed.

Substance Policy:

Smoking, vaping, Alcohol, Nicotine patches, E cigs, or being under the influence of any substances is strictly prohibited during the event. Smoking in OR out of campus is not allowed.

Identity and Confidentiality:

Using a false name, identity, or email address is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disqualification of the entire team. Any violation of cybersecurity laws during the event will also result in disqualification. No refunds will be issued in such cases.

Identification Requirement:

Your delegate tag must be worn and visible for all three days of the conference.

Weapons:

Any instrument that can inflict deliberate harm on someone is not permissible in OR around the campus.

Commitment to Fairness:

Every participant has the right to compete in an environment free from prejudice, intimidation, or discrimination. We are committed to ensuring fairness in every aspect of the event.

Punctuality:

Delegates are expected to follow the event schedule closely. Punctuality is essential and repeated delays may lead to penalties.

Respectful Discourse:

Delegates should engage in discussions in a way that ensures no participant feels distressed, excluded, or shamed for any aspect of their identity.

Zero Tolerance for Discrimination:

Any form of discriminatory behavior will not be tolerated. Every participant should feel valued, included, and respected at all times.

Accountability:

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in penalties, including warnings, disqualification, or other actions determined by the Executive Council. All decisions made by the council are final and binding.

Rules Of Procedure:

The rules and procedures followed at this MUN will follow those of HMUN 2026 unless changes are made at the discretion of the dais. The Pakistan National Assembly committee will follow a separate procedure.
